This position will perform a pre-operational safety maintenance checks, as well as accumulate and record bus log reports. Will maintain a clean and orderly bus. Other duties as assigned.

Education, Experience and Skills Required:

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must have a Class B commercial drivers license (CDL) with a passenger and school bus endorsement as well as Air Brake Certified
- This position is subject to a pre-employment criminal & child maltreatment background, sex offender registry check, Motor Vehicle Registry check, drug screen, and must pass DOT physical.
- Must possess a Bus Driver Certification Card
- Annually driver must complete 3 hours of state required training and 3 hours district in-service at driver expense
- Must be able to communicate effectively with staff, management, students and parents.
- Knowledge of basic vehicle maintenance.
- CPR and First Aid Certified
